In my last 2 terms (2022-2026), I chaired both the HR and RMSC subcoms.

I asked to handle HR because as Line Dance Vice-Convenor back in 2021/2022, I encountered internal politics amongst the rank and file.

My objective was to de-politicise our staff members so that they could perform without having to align themselves politically with any MC member. Now that politics is finally safely out of the picture, the staff can focus solely on their own performance and will be rewarded on their own merit.

I was subsequently tasked to chair the RMSC. I then nominated to the RMSC subcom those members amongst us who are community mediators. We are after all a social and recreation club. Not a school or regiment. Our disciplinary process exists not to penalise bad behaviour per se, but to help cultivate good behaviour for a pleasant club ambience. Most of all, it is not to be abused for any personal agenda. Community mediators are trained to harmonise conflicts and are able to maintain neutrality. Now, our disciplinary process runs like clockwork, fully administered by our club staff without any undue interference from any MC member or club member. Decisions are delivered by your respected fellow members and are fair and consistent.

You have seen the hard work of the 12 Good Men in our physical transformation project that will not complete until this year-end. We have come far and have not stopped working for the club since the day we were elected in Apr 2022. We don't see ourselves as volunteers but as members like all of you, dedicated to create the best club out of SRC. Because for far too long, our membership had little or no market value.

We cannot make promises to cut food and drink prices or reduce transfer fees in the midst of a severe fuel shortage and a potential global economic meltdown. It would be irresponsible for us not to watch our operating expenses and revenue streams in an inflationary environment. We also cannot promise that we will hold a townhall every 6 months because it would be a waste of time, money and resources to hold townhalls for the sake of holding townhalls. For those who may not be aware, townhalls in SRC were in fact initiated by the 12 Good Men and we will continue to hold townhalls to share important developments.

What we can promise you is this. We will always do our best for the club, wholeheartedly. Whether you support us or not, for as long as you are a member of this club, we value your contributions and hope you will value your club and not run it down. It took us all a lot of hard work to improve SRC's public profile and it can all come crashing down with bad social media posts about the club, the management and/or its MC. What happens in the club should be resolved in the club amicably. When you visit the club, bring along your smile and sunshine and let SRC be a place to meet wonderful people and make friends.

As Vice-President, I hope to represent your optimism and hope for a wholesome club experience at SRC. I will do my best to ensure prudence in policy-making and to harmonise all differences in our club.
